

Kanye West's Album 'Jesus Is King' Reportedly Delayed Over Christian Content

Rapper Kanye West's much-anticipated album *Jesus Is King*, originally slated for release Friday, has hit a bump in the road—and it might be because of the record's overtly Christian content.

West's wife, reality TV star Kim Kardashian, announced the set list for the album in a tweet posted in late August.
