

Momastery Christian Author Makes Bombshell Lesbian Announcement

Love Warrior author and Momastery blog founder Glennon Doyle Melton made a bombshell announcement over the weekend: She's dating soccer star Abby Wombach.

Doyle Melton, whose new book is an Oprah Book Club selection, recently separated from her husband, Craig, for the second time.

Doyle Melton posted the announcement to her social media channels.

"Feels like the world could use all the love it can get right now. So today, I'm going to share with you my new love," Doyle Melton writes. "Her name is Abby. You might recognize her from soccer. She was one of the best players of all time, and she has been a fierce and committed advocate for women's equality for a decade. And honestly? Those are the least impressive things about her."

Doyle Melton discussed her faith in a blog post several years ago.

The same-sex attraction announcement confused many of her followers who adhere to biblical truth.
