

New 'Time Capsule' Cave Discovery Shows Why Israel Remains the World's Archaeological Epicenter

A newly discovered cave in northern Israel is once again drawing the world's attention to the land of the Bible.

Archaeologists recently uncovered a remarkably preserved cave near Fureidis, south of Haifa, containing stone tools, animal remains and evidence of ancient human activity. Researchers have described the site as a rare "time capsule" because it remained largely undisturbed, preserving an extraordinary snapshot of the region's distant past.
