

Pastor Known for Marriage Teaching Arrested for Secret Double Life With Multiple Wives

A Florida pastor recognized for offering guidance on biblical marriage is now facing serious legal trouble after his arrest on bigamy charges.

According to Fox News, Leslie Williams, 62, was taken into custody at the census-designated place, The Villages, Florida, a large retirement community spanning three counties.

Authorities allege Williams entered into a marriage while still legally married to another woman, prompting charges that originated in Georgia.

Legal Case Centers on Overlapping Marriages

Investigators say official records indicate that Williams may have been involved in more than one marriage at the same time—an act that constitutes bigamy under the law.



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He is currently being held without bond as an out-of-state fugitive and is expected to be extradited to Georgia, where the case will proceed.

Public Ministry Now Under Scrutiny

The case has drawn increased attention because of Williams' role as a marriage teacher. As reported by Fox News, he authored a book to help men strengthen their relationships and love their wives well.

His ministry emphasized biblical principles of commitment and faithfulness—messages now being closely examined in light of the allegations.

The stark contrast between his public teachings and the accusations has sparked widespread discussion, particularly among those familiar with his work.

Social Media Post Prompted Questions

Questions about Williams reportedly surfaced after a social media post announcing a marriage, prompting confusion among some who believed he was already married.

That reaction appears to have contributed to further scrutiny, ultimately leading to the investigation and subsequent arrest.
