

Paula White Sets Up Big Meeting Between Donald Trump, Evangelicals

Donald Trump is making an appeal to evangelical voters by hosting a meeting with 30 Christian leaders, according to *The Wall Street Journal*.

Among those leaders will be Paula White, who has interviewed Trump on her program for many years.

The invitation-only event is planned for Sept. 28.

"Mr. Trump's goal is simple: to hear the heart of America's Christian leaders and learn what they feel are the most critical issues facing our nation today," Sheila Withum says.

The politician's blunt talk is one of the reasons he's the Republican front-runner.
