

Muslim Rapper Ice Cube Wants Third Term for President Obama

Four months ago, the actor and rapper known as “Ice Cube” said Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump was “what Americans love.” Now, he’s changed his tune.

During a profanity-laced interview on “Too \$hort’s BoomBox”—a podcast dedicated to politics and current events hosted by the West Coast hip-hop rapper, music producer and actor known as “Too \$hort”—Ice Cube said he wished President Obama could serve a third term.
