

Redeeming the Time

Awakening to a new season requires bringing an end to the grief of a previous one. Chuck D. Pierce follows up his best-selling *Interpreting the Times* with *Redeeming the Time* and makes “new” a central theme: new call, new day, new time. We are more likely to enter the new through a shaking, and the shift beneath us can be disconcerting at first.

Pierce warns that outward appearances can cause us to miss our time, declaring, “Overcome, or be overcome!” *Redeeming the Time* examines the concept that national political changes can be “indicators” of God’s purpose and lead to the unveiling of His overall plan for a given generation.

In the end, we can choose to participate in God’s transforming of earthly evils and harms by making choices of a personal nature, that, ultimately, can increase the kingdom just as much as spiritual battles waged by a body of believers.
