David Timms, author of the critically acclaimed *Living the Lord's Prayer*, discusses an interesting aspect of time in his follow-up, *Sacred Waiting: Waiting on God in a World That Waits for Nothing*. The former church planter and pastor explains the difference between how society views waiting in an ever-changing world that will stop for nothing and the power of God's perfect timing.

In an age when waiting is looked upon as a desert of frustration and anxiety, Timms encourages readers to experience such moments as an opportunity to be aware of God's voice and presence. Through biblical examples such as Noah and his enduring sacrifices and Abraham and his lessons in trust, Timms explains the value of waiting in order to experience God's defining truths and guidance. He teaches that in times of solitude, God's voice is most clearly heard, and each waiting process enriches life's journey through lessons learned that may draw the Christian into a deeper relationship with God.
