

# Sanctified Seed

Then thou shalt say before the Lord thy God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of mine house. **–Deuteronomy 26:13**

The hallowed things are those items that have been set aside and anointed by God Himself.

Belshazzar took the goblets from the House of God for his party, and his guests held them high as they toasted their pagan gods (Daniel 5:4). God didn't wait to punish him. That same night his enemies invaded the land and he was slain. Tithing is a non-negotiable issue in God's kingdom.
