Last November, the singer and his wife Luisana Lopilato, a model, announced that their little boy Noah was fighting cancer. But now, according to doctors, Noah is on the road to full recovery—and his parents and uncle are crediting God.

In a recent interview with an Argentinian newspaper, Bubl 's brother-in-law, actor Dario Lopilato, revealed the role God played.

"[I]t's very difficult to talk about," he told La Naci n. "But I believe in God and sought comfort in Jesus Christ and a miracle from God came, from the way it [the cancer] was discovered, after the operation, everything."

He confirmed Noah was doing “very, very well.”

According to Lopilato, Noah’s fight against cancer brought the whole family together. “[I]t was something that has united us a lot as a family,” the uncle added. “God exists.” {eo}

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
