

'The Chosen' Reveals Major Season 6 Release Date

The Chosen is back with its biggest and most epic season yet.

In a short, powerful Facebook post, the popular show depicting Jesus' life and journey with His disciples shared an update on when the show would return for Season 6.

The post simply read, "The Chosen story continues Nov. 15 Prime Video." However, it was the image of Jesus wearing a crown of thorns, a robe and carrying the cross that sparked emotional intrigue.

As Deadline noted, the next season of The Chosen will hit Prime on Nov. 15, with three episodes launching that day. After that, one new episode will be released each week through Dec. 6, with the season finale and the premiere of Season 7 hitting theaters in the spring of 2027.
