

The Family That Prays Together Stays Together

Did you know that family is on God's heart?

In this episode of *Truth Talks* on the Charisma Podcast Network, Pastor Ché Ahn shares a simple but powerful truth: The family that prays together stays together. As the capstone teaching in the series "The Church Is God's Family," this message highlights three truths about prayer in the context of the church community.

In the Gospels, Jesus talks about prayer in the context of the church, the *ekklesia*. The modern-day perception of "church" is typically focused on a church building, but the body of Christ—the true church—goes beyond the walls of a building. The church is wherever we are, as sons and daughters of God, as born-again followers of Jesus.

This episode of *Truth Talks with Pastor Ché* unpacks the biblical definition of the *ekklesia* as two or three who gather in Jesus' name: the basic family unit. Whenever we are gathered together with other believers, God sees His family coming together in unity. It's in this place, as family, where our prayers will release exponential power.

"This is God's heart, that we come together in united prayer so we advance His Kingdom," Ahn says.

The Bible clearly shows us the way to seeing our prayers answered. Get ready to dig deep into these three keys that will revitalize your prayer life: No. 1: Pray in agreement. No. 2: Pray to the Father in Jesus' name. No. 3: Pray according to God's will.
