

The Grassroots Demand: Let's Put 'Us' Back in the USA

One of America's largest and most respected grassroots activist organizations, Heritage Action For America (HAFA), is now officially part of the Grassroots For Victory USA (G4VUSA) "Let's Put 'US' Back In USA" 2015-2016 National Tour and G4VUSA agree that for too long, big government special interests have dominated Washington; and, that Washington should work for America's best interests and be held accountable to ensure they do. HAFA takes conservative policy visions outlined by their sister organization, the Heritage Foundation, and makes them a reality. launch: Becky Gerritson, from Wetumpka, Alabama, who came to national prominence after testifying before Congress regarding the IRS scandal; Pastor Dexter Sanders of Orlando, the Tour's Senior Faith Advisor; and, recording artist and Jacksonville native Jennifer Renee, whose recording of the song *Let's Put 'US' Back In The USA* was one of the inspirations for the National Tour project.
