Maybe it’s the gift that has great value to the giver? That’s it.

Father God gave us His Son—His one and only Son.

That’s extravagant.

So extravagant, many cannot believe it happened.

“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved” (John 3:16, NKJV).

His name was Jesus Christ, and He came with gifts. His gifts to us are the gift of grace, the gift of salvation, the gift

of the Holy Spirit and the gift of eternal life.

We were banking when Christ showed up. He saved us from ourselves.

Here's how He came:

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with a child of the Holy Spirit.
