Like many others, as a child, Lisa Robertson never fully understood her faith. And as she grew older, she only had one question: "God, are you real?"

While in college, confused and seeking answers, she prayed her first earnest prayer and asked God to reveal Himself to her. Otherwise, she would go about her life without Him.
