Upon reflecting on Acts 2:17 and Joel 2:28 which talks about men dreaming dreams and sons and daughters prophesying, Armstrong says, “I would submit to you that before we see that outpouring and sons and daughters, there have to be fathers’ hearts turning first.”

And, Armstrong goes on to say, “If you’ve never been a father, there’s an invitation to be fathered by Him.” Learning to own our sonship and daughtership as children of God will allow us to see the wonderful Father the Lord is to us, thereby setting the example for us, in turn, to be fathers to the next generation.

Armstrong acknowledges, “I can’t help but see throughout the body and throughout the nation, that there’s been other substitutions” for fathers or father figures. He goes on to say, “Even Elijah said, ‘Where’s the God of our fathers?’ I would say, ‘Where are the fathers after God?’”
