Duggar daughters Jill Dillard and Jessa Seewald are returning to TLC despite the network canceling the family's reality show, *19 Kids and Counting*.

The Seewalds and Dillards are the new stars of *Jill & Jessa: Counting On*, which follows the lives of the sisters as they navigate adulthood and the changes that come with it, according to a statement from the network.

The Duggar family was booted from TLC following revelations oldest son Josh Duggar molested five minors, including Jill and Jessa.
