initially, ranging from fever and headache to shortness of breath. One to 10 days later, a rash can appear on the extremities, head or torso that eventually turns into blisters filled with pus. Overall, symptoms usually last for two to four weeks, while skin lesions usually scab over in 14 to 21 days.”

Google Censors 17,000 Doctors Aiming to Restore Scientific Integrity

Global COVID Summit, which represents 17,000 physicians and medical scientists, released its fourth declaration on May 11. Google censored the news by not allowing the group or its declaration to appear in its search results until the bottom of Page 3. On the DuckDuckGo search engine, it appeared at the top of Page 1.

The majority of headlines featured in the Google search results included these words: “Biden,” “White House,” “Global COVID-19 Summit” and “world leaders.”

Declaration IV accuses “big tech, media, academics, and government agencies” of profiting from the “orchestrated catastrophe” of COVID-19. Declaration IV takes aim at those

institutions as well as accusing “Pfizer, Moderna, BioNTech, Janssen, AstraZeneca and their enablers” of fraud. {eo}

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
