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'Mandisa Is Home': Grammy-Winning Christian Artist Mandisa Dies at 47

Mandisa Lynn Hundley, the Christian singer-songwriter and

"American Idol" finalist known professionally as Mandisa, has died in her Nashville, Tennessee, home at age 47, according to multiple reports.

Born in California, the platinum-selling artist and five-time Grammy nominee rose to fame when she responded with grace to "American Idol" judge Simon Cowell's critique following her Season 5 performance. She finished in the top 10 and in 2007, released her first album, "True Beauty." In 2014, she won a Grammy for Best Contemporary Christian Music album for her iconic release, "Overcomer."

K-LOVE, one of the first outlets to break the news of her death, posted the following on social media platform X:
