- Build a wall along America's southern border and make Mexico pay for it.
- Undo President Obama's nuclear deal with Iran and

increase sanctions on terror-sponsoring regimes.

“Looking at this list of extremely important and urgent needs for America,” Strang said, “President Trump is holding steadfast to his commitments, and these goals are being realized. How many presidents in modern history have taken as many measured and successful steps toward their campaign promises and their party’s agenda?”
