Jason Crabb, a soulful Southern gospel celebrity who left his family group and embarked on a more eclectic solo career, encourages readers who are going through hard times, in *Trusting God to Get You Through: Lessons I've Learned Through the Fire About Grace, Loss and Love*.

Lyrics from "Through the Fire," a song his father wrote, accompany each of the book's eight chapters, which address topics including loneliness, finding strength in weakness, God's protection and refusing to give in to the enemy of the believer's soul.

The oldest son in The Crabb Family, he tells of the challenges and blessings of being raised in a traveling, gospel-singing group, and of his own personal trials, such as his parents' eventual divorce and the miscarriages his wife, Shellye, suffered before the birth of their two daughters.

Crabb focuses the reader's attention on God's character, reassuring them that they can walk through the fires of adversity with His help. Readers needing compassion and

encouragement will find it here, and this debut book should draw fans of the Grammy-nominated artist and his well-known family.

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
