

Twenty-One Days of Prayer: Example of Fatherliness

There was a concert on the Mall in Washington DC that my wife and I attended, organized by Sean Feucht; the concert was called "Let Us Worship." It was held on September 11, 2021 to commemorate the 20th anniversary of September 11, 2001, a day of infamy. Donald J.
