

UPDATE: 'Cult Mom' Focus of Upcoming Netflix Series

With a preview that is engrossed in dark, spiritual oppression, Netflix has released a trailer for their new documentary series, *Sins of Our Mother*.

This series sits down with Colby Vallow, Lori Vallow's lone remaining child, as he recounts the events leading up to the deaths of Joshua "J.J" Vallow, Tylee Ryan and Tammy Daybell, and the aftermath of media sensationalism, investigations and court hearings.

Lori Vallow and Chad Daybell stand accused of multiple counts each of conspiracy to commit first-degree murder and grand theft by deception.

The series is focused on the dark, downward spiral that Vallow took after meeting Daybell, an apocalyptic author. This family cult that Chad created was based off Mormon teachings. Proclaiming he could discern the evil spirits from good, Lori claims she believed the only way to save her children's souls was to free them from their earthly bodies.
