

Why Is Forrest Frank No Longer Attending Award Shows? What the Star Had to Say

Wildly popular Christian singer-songwriter Forrest Frank announced on social media this week he will no longer attend award shows because “the trophy is our salvation.”

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One year ago, the “God Is Good” singer attended the Gospel Music Association’s Dove Awards, where he accepted the prize for New Artist of the Year.
