

# Why Is Obama Still Around?

"I personally think," Strang added, "and I document this in *Trump Aftershock*, that Democrats are shooting themselves in the foot with this tactic. But regardless, it's scary for America, because the pendulum tends to swing from one party to

the other, and if these socialists get into power, eventually the Democrats will have the White House again and one or both houses of Congress. That is why as I'm doing media interviews, writing and speaking; I'm encouraging people who are like-minded to get out and vote. Donald Trump is very strong, but he can't do it alone, and we need to give him a House and Senate that will actually back the things he's trying to do."
