

Worn-Out Hillary Clinton Takes Questions From Press After Debate ... for 3 Minutes

Shortly after taking another beating—physical, psychological and strategic—in the third and final presidential debate, Democratic presidential nominee looked the part while lamenting she wouldn't be taking any naps anymore.

“It's been a year and now we've finished our last debate and I'm feeling relieved and very grateful,” told her embedded press contingent during an impromptu press conference aboard her campaign plane. “I just wanted to come back and say hello. Some of you have been on the trail the whole time. No more debates. No more naps.”
