

You Won't Believe What Jeb Bush Said About Donald Trump

Politics, in many ways, is like warfare. So even though former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush really doesn't like businessman Donald Trump, the enemy of his enemy—every once in a while, at least—is his friend.

You can thank Hillary Clinton for that.

During an interview Monday for “Bill Bennett’s Morning in America” radio program, the former GOP presidential front-runner had this to say about the guy currently leading in nearly all the polls:

“Hillary Clinton suggesting that Donald Trump is being used in an ISIS recruiting video, man, talk about chutzpah. There’s no evidence of that. There’s no evidence of that at all.”
