

Hamas Threatens to Kill Hostages, Plunge World Into Apocalypse

Tensions in the ongoing Israel-Hamas conflict escalated dramatically following a chilling new threat from Hamas that any further escalation by Israel “will result in the deaths of the remaining hostages.”

This comes just a day after President Trump delivered a forceful ultimatum warning the terrorist group, “Release all of the Hostages now ... or it is OVER for you.”
