

Cindy Clemishire Calls Out Robert Morris' Shocking Plea—Christian Community in Uproar

Cindy Clemishire has responded to Robert Morris' "not guilty" plea following his surrender to authorities after he was indicted for five counts of lewd or indecent acts with a child for sexually abusing Clemishire, which started when she was only 12.

Clemishire told the Christian Post that Morris' "not guilty" plea did not catch her off-guard.

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"It did not surprise is my understanding any attorney would advise their client to plead not guilty. It gives the criminal the opportunity to negotiate a plea," she told the Post.

Since Morris' plea, other people across the internet have also taken different stances on this tragic story.
