

Satanic Temple to Open Abortion Telehealth Center to Honor Trump's Birthday

Not all birthday gifts are pleasant and welcoming.

The Satanic Temple has something disgusting planned for President Trump's birthday: the opening of a telehealth abortion center which would offer women prescriptions so they can carry out an "abortion ritual."

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According to the Christian Post, this facility is set to open on Saturday as part of TST Health with the intention of a free clinic with the exception of the charge to their pharmacy partner, Honeybee Health, which provides the abortion prescription.

The center is to be located in Maine and will be called "The President's Yuge Most Beautiful Satanic Abortion Clinic."

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Providing a statement to the Post, the TST executive director Erin Helian said, "We know just how much our President appreciates freedom and the fundamental right to hope he receives this clinic's distinguished title as the magnificent, regal birthday present it is intended to be."
