

25,000 Flood Streets of Paris to March for Jesus

Praise, prayer and the Word of God filled the streets of Paris this weekend as more than 25,000 people participated in the March For Jesus in France.

The organizers told that the gathering “allowed Christians of all denominations to raise the name of Jesus above their theological differences.”

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“We opened ourselves to the entire evangelical Protestant spectrum thanks to the participation of several churches such as MLK, Hillsong, ICC, but also Baptist, charismatic, and more traditional Protestant churches. This is my role, as coordinator, to keep unity and unite around Jesus,” Gilbert Léonien, the pastor in charge of the Paris march told the French outlet, .

According to the “March For Jesus France” website, the first such march took place in Paris in 1991 and was later organized in smaller cities.

But this year’s march in Paris broke its record with more than 25,000 participants, according to French authorities. Participation in the four other cities reached the thousands.

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
