

27 Christians Killed as Jihadists Aim to 'Wipe Out the Entirety of Christianity in Nigeria'

A new tragedy is being reported in the ongoing genocide against Christians in Nigeria. At least 27 Christians have been killed in attacks over the past day.

The situation in Plateau State, Nigeria, involves an ongoing escalation of violent attacks targeting Christian communities. According to reports from Truth Nigeria and International Christian Concern, these attacks are characterized by nighttime raids on villages, resulting in significant loss of life, including children and families.



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CBN News spoke with Truth Nigeria's Masara Kim, who is on the ground with the details.

"This highlights the intentions, the motivations of these terrorists. It is to wipe out the entirety of Christianity in Nigeria. This is not about climate change, and this is not about farmer-herder clashes... This is clear religious and ethnic targeting," Masara Kim reports.

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
