installed at the Fordow Fuel Enrichment Plant near the city of Qom as well as additional clusters that are undergoing construction at the unground Natanz facility and several other nuclear complexes.”

According to a Leaked Report by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA); Iran has gone into “Overdrive” on Uranium Enrichment since the Resolution by the U.K, France, and Germany, on the Censuring of the Iranian Nuclear Program, was Passed by the IAEA Board of Governors...
