

# After Tragic Accident, Reinhard Bonnke Sets Up Fund for Bradley Braland's Family

As Charisma News previously reported, one of the leading team members of **Christ for all Nations** (CfaN), Bradley Braland, died suddenly on Saturday, Oct. 26, 2013, in a car accident.

Director of CfaN's communications, publications and print media, Braland passionately served on staff at CfaN for more than 10 years.
