

After US-Russia Summit, Trump to Hold Key Meeting With Zelenskyy

After President Trump met with Vladimir Putin on Friday in Alaska without coming to a peace ceasefire deal, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy is now coming to the United States to meet with the president.
