

Anna Paulina Luna Sets Date for Bombshell MK Ultra Investigation Hearing

A Cold War-era intelligence program once shrouded in secrecy is returning to public scrutiny.

Rep. Anna Paulina Luna, R-Fla., announced that a House Oversight Task Force will hold a hearing May 13 focused on MK Ultra, a covert CIA initiative tied to mind control experimentation, according to a report from Fox Baltimore.

The announcement has reignited interest in one of the most controversial programs in U.S. intelligence history and raised new questions about what information may still remain hidden.

What Was MK Ultra?

MK Ultra was a classified CIA program developed during the Cold War to explore methods of influencing human behavior, including the control of the mind.
