

Are Capitol Evacuation Drills Foretold in New Book?

Capitol Police conducted a campus-wide evacuation drill recently in Washington, D.C. The official alert described it as routine, with road closures on Constitution Avenue, Independence Avenue and D Street NE, as buildings across the Capitol complex temporarily cleared.
