While Israel has never threatened a nation with a nuclear attack, nor have they ever even acknowledged that they have nuclear warheads, it is simply assumed that they do. Iran was not mentioned once within the resolution, even though it threatens Israel and the United States with destruction regularly.

As reported by ALL ISRAEL NEWS, this vote comes on the heels of another anti-Israel vote that commemorated the founding of "Nakba Day—"nakba" is the Arabic word for "disaster," or "catastrophe."

In spite of all the hatred and violence targeted for Israel, there is reassurance in the fact that God will protect His people. Israel will not be wiped off the earth despite the constant threat from anti-Semitic countries.
