

Boris Vujicic, Father of 'Life Without Limbs' Nick Vujicic, Dies

Boris Vujicic is the father of *New York Times* best-selling author and international evangelist Nick Vujicic, who was born without any limbs.

In *Raising the Perfectly Imperfect Child: Facing Challenges With Strength, Courage and Hope* (WaterBrook) Boris shared the remarkable journey of how he and his wife, Dushka, overcame their grief, fears and badly shaken faith to raise an accomplished, faith-filled and perfectly imperfect son. Boris Vujicic served as Chief Systems and Financial Officer for Attitude is Altitude, Inc., the organization established by Nick Vujicic. Born in Yugoslavia, Boris immigrated with his family to Australia where he and his wife started two churches and helped in the missions and ministry of several more churches in other countries.
