

# Charisma News Brief: Florida Braces for Hurricane Idalia's Impact on Gulf Coast

Florida is on high alert as Hurricane Idalia, the first major hurricane of the season, gains strength and sets its sights on the Gulf Coast. Forecasters predict that Idalia could escalate to a Category 3 hurricane by Tuesday night, raising concerns among residents and officials alike.
