

Chick-fil-A Breaks World Sales Record After Hateful Attacks

What the enemy meant for harm, God turned around for good.

The gay agenda sought to besmirch Chick-fil-A's business after president and chief operating officer, **Dan Cathy**, made his beliefs about traditional marriage known to the radio listening world. The company has been maligned, protested and otherwise attacked.
