

China Now Warning the US: 'Ready for War'

The world just took a step closer to a global showdown.

China has openly declared it is "ready for war" with the United States, a chilling statement that echoes across newsrooms worldwide. This isn't just political bluster—it's a direct challenge to American power, and one that could have prophetic implications.

"The Washington Post" reported that U.S. military strategy has shifted from counterterrorism to "great power competition." That means fewer small-scale conflicts and more focus on deterring rivals like China and Russia with high-tech weaponry. But even with all of America's military advantages, a war with China would be unlike anything we've faced before. As a defense analyst told the BBC, "This isn't just saber-rattling; it's a signal of intent backed by capability."
