BREAKING: Recall Petition for California Gov. Newsom to Appear on Ballot

The petition to recall California Gov. Gavin Newsom has surpassed the number of signatures needed for the recall to appear on the ballot, announced on its Facebook page last night.

"We did this!" organizer Solis Flower announced in a Facebook Live video. "This was through the California Patriots Coalition ... I just want to tell you guys that we are beyond blessed."

"The reason that I want to recall Gov. Newsom is because he

Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis Rejects Critical Race Theory for Proposed Civics Curriculum

Florida Republican Gov. Ron DeSantis announced in a press conference Wednesday a proposed civics education curriculum for the state, one that would “expressly exclude” critical race theory.

“Florida’s civics curriculum will incorporate foundational concepts with the best materials, and it will expressly exclude unsanctioned narratives like critical race theory and other unsubstantiated theories,” DeSantis said. “Let me be clear: There is no room in our classrooms for things like critical race theory.

“Teaching kids to hate their country and to hate each other is not worth one red cent of taxpayer money.” {eo}

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
