Christian Artist Says Mark of the Beast Looms on Horizon

Christian singer Danny Gokey posted a lengthy Twitter thread at the end of August explaining not only why he's opposed to vaccination mandates but also voicing his concerns the "mark of the beast," as it's described in the book of Revelation, could be on the horizon.

The "Jesus People" singer—who is vaccinated against COVID-19—said people shouldn't be forced to get inoculated against the virus if they don't want to, calling out many in the government and news media who tout it as "a cure" when it's not.

He also lamented the fact that people no longer have conversations because "the only topic discussed is COVID, and the only acceptable thought is vaccination," a phenomenon he described as "very dangerous."

That powerful word comes from Messianic Rabbi Curt Landry, who writes and speaks on the Jewish roots of the Christian faith. "The Festival of Tabernacles, the thing that's so exciting about that, its central theme is to say, 'God, I'm reminding You of Your covenant promises to me,'" Landry tells Dr. Steve

Greene on a recent episode of *Greenelines* on the Charisma Podcast Network, speaking of the upcoming feast in the Jewish calendar, Sept. 20-27. “But more importantly, God, You’re reminding me of the covenant promises You made tonight—me and my family.

“And so it’s just a fall refreshing, restarting, renewing,” Landry says. “And to me, I think it’s probably one of the most practical things, habits and patterns that people can do. And it comes from God. It’s not a Jewish thing per se. It’s a Judeo-Christian, biblical thing ... in every place in the Bible where it talks about the festivals, or the feasts of the Lord, it says, ‘These are the feasts of the Lord.’
