Financial Expert Uncovers Tech Giant Facebook: 'Pure Evil'

In an interview on the Fox News show "Mornings with Maria" on Monday, the founder of Michael Lee Strategy ripped Facebook and its founder Mark Zuckerberg for being one of the "worst companies ever created and maligned the social media giant for becoming so big and powerful.

Facebook is reeling from the events of the past couple of days. On Sunday, "60 Minutes" did an expose on the company when former employee Frances Haugen says that, in her time with Facebook, she saw "conflicts of interest between what was good for the public and what was good for Facebook."

Haugen, referred to as a "whistleblower," says Facebook "chooses profits over safety" in an interview with "60 Minutes'" Scott Pelley.

Israeli Archaeologists Make Unusual and Rare Discovery of 2,700-Year-Old Artifact

Israeli archaeologists have found a rare ancient toilet in Jerusalem dating back more than 2,700 years, when private bathrooms were a luxury in the holy city, authorities said Tuesday.

The Israeli Antiquities Authority said the smooth, carved limestone toilet was found in a rectangular cabin that was part of a sprawling mansion overlooking what is now the Old City. It was designed for comfortable sitting, with a deep septic tank dug underneath.

"A private toilet cubicle was very rare in antiquity, and only a few were found to date," said Yaakov Billig, the director of the excavation. {eoa}

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
