## King Charles III's Controversial Approach to Defender of the Faith

Charles III became king on Sept. 8, 2022 when his mother Queen Elizabeth II died. Two days later he was proclaimed king by the Accession Council of the United Kingdom. In 2023 King Charles will have his coronation. A coronation is a holy moment, where he will be anointed with oil and asked if he will maintain the Christian faith.

There has been a lot of speculation on how the king will operate in his position as the 'Defender of the Faith.' During Queen Elizabeth's reign, she was vocal about her Christian beliefs and dependency upon God.

Friday, the king met with leaders across multiple faiths to talk about the future of the role. "I have always thought of Britain as a 'community of communities' that has led me to understand that the sovereign has an additional duty—less formally recognized but to be no less diligently discharged," the king said in the meeting.
