Dedicated Missions Leader Howard Foltz Dies at 83

The Foltzs founded AIMS with the purpose of challenging and mobilizing churches to take the gospel where it has never been proclaimed. AIMS has trained over 170,000 pastors and leaders worldwide to engage in a cross-cultural ministry and church-planting movements among the world's least-reached people groups, while thousands of churches have been planted by indigenous partners.
