President Trump's Election Challenge Powered by Prayer and Legal Actions

Monday, Pennsylvania transitioned from blue to gray on the national map tracking Republican and Democrat wins by state in the presidential election. Unlike most media outlets, RealClear Politics has not called the race for former Vice President Joe Biden. It shows Biden/Harris with 259 electoral votes and Trump/Pence with 214. It takes 270 votes from the Electoral College to win the election.

Monday afternoon, President Trump requested all Christians pray as he and his representatives went before the U.S. Supreme Court regarding legal grounds to fight the outcome of the election. Shortly thereafter, Pennsylvania was no longer locked in as a Biden victory.

Supreme Court Hears Obamacare Case for Third Time

The U.S. Supreme Court is hearing a third major legal

challenge to the Affordable Care Act (ACA), or Obamacare, to decide if the law is unconstitutional.

The lawsuit, California v. Texas, comes from a group of 18 Republican-led states and two individuals who live in Texas. It argues the ACA should be struck down after the financial penalty for not buying health insurance was reduced to \$0 in a 2017 tax law passed by a Republican Congress and President Trump. {eo}
