

Could This be the Location of Noah's Ark?

Did archaeologists unearth the actual location of Noah's Ark?

According to Fox News, the organization, Noah's Ark Scans, believe they are seeing the possibility of "ancient wood" in one area of Turkey due to the recent results from samples of soil.

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In a statement, the organization said that these samples "show significantly higher levels of organic matter and potassium compared to surrounding areas."
