

'Cult Mom' Displays Demoniac Smile in Court

With her children being listed as missing for months, Vallow Daybell and her husband left Idaho for Hawaii while allegedly collecting their dead children’s social security allotments. Her expressions of joy in the midst of a murder trial for children, and an ex-wife of her husband, run opposite to what real joy is.
